

**7:30 pm** Vespers and adoration



The retreat will start at **5:30 pm on Friday** and will finish at 6:00 pm on Sunday.



You can also experience a *School of Life*, a longer time of discernment or sabbatical, living our simple daily life of prayer and service.







## A Place of Grace: *The Grotto*

### Contemplative Life


“Before all else let God be loved!” “Seated at the feet of the Lord” (Lk.10:39) we keep the Word of God, and ponder it in our hearts with the Virgin Mary. We draw this Living Water of the Word of God from the pierced heart of Jesus on the Cross-, from the daily Eucharist, from the Eucharistic Adoration, and from the long celebration of the Divine Office, day and night, in this contemplative life that reveals to us the mystery of the Lamb.

### **Fraternal Life**

The little brothers and little sisters have a common resolve in life and at times gather together for liturgical prayer. In the heart of the Church, consecrated to living the Gospel of Our Lord Jesus Christ, they are gathered in fraternal unanimity *“to be one mind and one heart in God.”* Their daily life, however, is separate.

### **Missionary Life**

Witnesses of the mystery of the Lamb, the little sisters and the little brothers of the Lamb go as pilgrims, praying, poor, and begging in the footsteps of Saint Dominic and Saint Francis to encounter the poorest of this world, so that all, rich and poor alike, might receive the Light of the Gospel: Jesus, the Lamb of God – the tenderness of the Father for all men.
